The caregivers in our neighborhood are specially trained to work with and care for those with Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia. And, our caregivers and residents are partnered throughout the resident's stay at *The Legacy*, allowing the staff to become closely acquainted with their personal preferences.

We know that each resident brings their own special life experiences to our neighborhood, and *The Legacy* is designed to meet these individual needs.

Those living with memory loss may sometimes forget, but our Legacy neighborhood gently stimulates the memory using reminders of the past such as photographs, objects and scents.



Features of our neighborhood include:

- A design that is sensitive to the needs of those with memory challenges, including "life stations" that encourage residents to engage in familiar tasks, and décor encouraging memories of days gone by
- Activity programs designed to be responsive to the energy patterns of those living with dementia
- Secured courtyard that promotes regular contact with nature
- Family-style dining
- Private Bedrooms with Private Bath
